Here are a few helpful tips about what to expect during the inspection process:

- 1. DBC inspectors always call prior to an inspection and schedule an appointment if necessary.
- 2. DBC inspectors are issued identification badges with the following features:
  - a color DBC logo like the one at the top of this letter
  - the name and a color photo of the field inspector
  - the back of the ID will have our mailing address
- 3. DBC inspectors will take exterior and interior (if applicable) photos of your home.
- 4. It is the inspector's job to provide information about the home and premises to the <u>insurance company</u>. The inspector checks for visible dwelling construction elements such as, but not limited to: exterior wall construction, roof coverings, plumbing lines, electrical service, foundations, wind-resistive fasteners, doors, windows, decks/patios and attached/detached structures (i.e. swimming pool, garage, shed).
- 5. Depending on the type of inspection ordered, the inspector may ask questions about the home's interior to generate a replacement cost estimate.
- 6. DBC inspectors will never request money for inspection services.
- 7. DBC inspectors will never recommend contractors or repair companies.
